### WHAT IS A COLLAGE?

**COLLAGE:** A WORK OF ART MADE BY GLUING PIECES OF DIFFERENT MATERIALS TO A FLAT SURFACE.

This collage uses construction paper to create a beautiful landscape!

...and no scissors are required!

### SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Glue

Construction Paper

Optional Supplies:

Scissors (for details)

Colored pencils (for details)

Printed paper (for details)

\*\*\*Use the leftover scraps or printed paper to create details if you wish.

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Choose a piece of paper for your background.
2. Choose the paper for your landscape features.
3. Tear the paper you've chosen for your landscape features into strips. Try to create interesting lines, like mountains and hills!
4. Glue the torn paper on your background paper and watch your landscape take shape!
