WHAT IS ORIGAMI?

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Glue

Construction Paper

Origami Paper

Optional Supplies:

Scissors (for ocean details)

Colored pencils (for ocean details)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Choose a piece of paper for your ocean background.
2. Choose the paper for your origami fish!
3. Follow the directions on the Origami Handout.
4. Glue your origami fish to your ocean background.
5. Optional: create coral, bubbles, or other elements for your ocean background with the
